


FROM THE PASTOR

Revelation 22:18 (NIV) I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds anything to them, God will add to him the plagues described in this book. And if anyone takes words away from this book of prophecy, God will take away from him his share in the tree of life and in the holy city, which are described in this book.

Have you ever wondered how the Bible has remained without errors for over 20 Centuries? It is good to remember that the Person of the Holy Spirit is involved with the keeping of Scripture. The warning that is given in the book of Revelation can be used for the whole Bible. It is sad that so many false religions have thought it necessary to add or subtract from the Word of God. The Mormons have the writings of Joseph Smith and the Jehovah's Witnesses have the writings and teaching of Charles Taze Russell. At the same time the Catholic Church has the decrees and teachings of the Vatican. It is too bad that many people in our world use the Bible as a book of "proof texts". I have head scripture quoted to support bigotry, racism, homosexuality, and just the other day and someone told me that Scripture supported the smoking of marijuana.

The Word of God is given in its entirety for all people to follow. We must not treat our Bibles like they are loose leaf editions and throw away all Scriptures that we feel are irrelevant or convicting. The warnings of the Lord in the last chapter are pretty stern. If you add to the book, (like the Jehovah's witnesses), you will have the plagues spoken of passed on to you. If you take away anything, you will be left out of heaven. I believe that God is concerned that we do not alter His wonderful, inspired word. It is still profitable for correction in our lives and to point the way to righteous living. The Lord does not address the issue of ignoring the Word, but I can only come to the conclusion that accountability will be demanded in that area also. May we this day promise the Lord that we will follow his word.
