

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church family,

You may have heard the phrase as a child, "actions speak louder than words." There is a lot of truth to that statement. Our values are on display every day in so many ways, for our friends, family and community to observe. We demonstrate our values most clearly in the ways we choose to spend our time, our money, and our energy.

Children are keen observers. They watch their parents, they listen to their interactions, and they usually can distinguish between the hypocrisy of their parents words and their daily actions.
