FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church family,

Matthew 12:43-45 (NIV) "When an evil spirit comes out of a man, it goes through arid places seeking rest and does not find it. Then it says, 'I will return to the house I left.' When it arrives, it finds the house unoccupied, swept clean and put in order. Then it goes and takes with it seven other spirits more wicked than itself, and they go in and live there. And the final condition of that man is worse than the first. That is how it will be with this wicked generation."

The peril of trying to live our lives by moral goodness alone is illustrated in this parable. The man in this story was apparently religious and had even went through with the process of having a demon exorcised. Today, many people try to clean up their lives by becoming religious. They have tried many other paths to find help from their problems and have not had success, so they try religion. They become involved in the church and find happiness for a short time. They feel a sense of contentment and purpose, and then a problem occurs that hits them totally off guard. Disillusionment sets in and they soon fall away from the church and begin to indulge in sins that are more evil than before they found religion.

The Jews were prime examples of trying to live by moral cleanliness without a true abiding presence of God within their lives. They had reduced a relationship with God to a set of laws and practices that were external. Their hearts remained sinful and full of evil works. It is easy for a person to mistake a true relationship with God with a set of religious propositions.

I am convinced that there are many on our church rolls today that have turned sour against the church and religion because their experience was self-generated instead of life changing. People had let them down, while they never had an exciting relationship with the Lord and a filling of the Holy Spirit. Maybe you are disillusioned with the Church or those who call themselves "Christians". Examine your experience and make sure it is valid and genuine. The power of Christ will keep the demons of sin from returning.
