

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church family,

This afternoon I will have the opportunity to conduct another Discovering Church Membership Seminar. I am always happy to teach this class which enables people to make a decision about becoming a part of the Eau Gallie First Baptist family. I love the opportunity to share about the mission and vision of our church as well as the doctrines that undergirds our faith in the Word of God.

Many churches today don't offer such a class because they do not believe that Church membership is biblical or important. The life of a disciple is a life of commitment. Since the Church is the Bride of Christ and is made up of the Body of Christ, expressing a desire to connect with a local church family is biblical and necessary. Membership is necessary for accountability and for the purpose of truly becoming members of one another. The New Testament speaks of the relationship that the early believers had with one another. There are actually 59 "one anothers" that speak of the special bond that we should have with other believers in the church body. "Love One Another", "Be devoted to one another", "Live in harmony", "Instruct One Another", and "Serve One Another" are just a few that I will mention.

Just like a family is made up of fathers, mothers, sons, daughters, grandmothers and the like, a Church family is knitted together through a blood relationship with one another through the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross. Just as a team has a roster, an organization has designated members, our church asks for people to commit to the local church body. While, for many membership is taken lightly and the covenant is often broken, the decision of membership is an important step to growing in a commitment to Jesus Christ.

Pray for those who are taking this important step today, and if you are not committed to this local church body, I ask that you pray about what God would lead you to do. There is still time to come. I hope to see you at 4pm.
