FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church family,

This past week I read a posting on Facebook from one of our former members. Mike Sonnenschien. Mike and is wife. Hope. retired from the US Army and were led by God to go and serve the people in Haiti. They spend their days teaching children English, working in the Medical Clinic and helping with the running of the Deep River Mission Center. What struck me about Mike's post was a conversation he had with a 18 year old young man he had been befriending. The young man asked Mike, "How did you sleep last night?" In which Mike replied, "Pretty well, thank you" and "why do you ask?" He replied that he was always thankful when he was given a good nights sleep and considered that to be a great blessing from God. Mike shared that in America we rarely would think that a good night's sleep was blessing because we have so many other material blessings, and that we usually equate blessings with worldly goods.

In today's message we are exploring the Biblical command to Love. In fact, this message compliments our Church Vision of "Love God, Love People, Share Jesus, Reach the World." Our mind set of the definition of Love usually doesn't usually include the idea of sacrifice and humility. In fact, we usually only express our love toward others when they are receptive and easy to love. We rarely consider the scriptural command to love one another as something we should do even when the other person is unloving. Loving God and Loving others in many people's practices, focuses on whether or not someone is worthy of our love, and we usually demand that our love toward others is repaid or reciprocated.

When I think of Mike and Hope and the many other people who answer God's call to give up creature comforts and financial gain in order to share God's love to people, causes me to reevaluate my motives for serving the Lord. I pray that I am following God's call on my life to make a difference in the place he had planted me. I pray that as you consider this message on "One Love" that you will take some time to reflect on whether or not you love others in a way that reflects God's great love given to you through the sacrifice of our Savior, Jesus Christ.
