FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church family,

We just completed a wonderful week of Vacation Bible School. It was wonderful to watch the kids enjoy the music, teaching, recreation and mission time each day. A mom stopped me on the way out of dropping off her son and said, "Your church does the best VBS!" I replied, "Thank you! We have a lot of folks in our church that love kids and want them to discover God's love."

VBS, like many other events and ministries that we are involved in throughout the year would be defined as an "Outreach Event". Throughout the year we offer Craft and Car shows, Trunk or Treat, Adult Fellowship Lunches, Youth Camps and Events, and special music concerts like the Celebrate Freedom, as well as weekly ministries of helping those in need with food, clothing, and financial assistance. Our weekday Preschool would be classified as an outreach ministry of the church.

The underlying purpose of outreach is not just to meet needs in the community, it is "establishing a beachhead for evangelism in a person's life." Dr. Rick Warren, author of the Purpose Driven Church, writes that "anybody can be won to Christ if you discover the key to his or her heart...the most likely place to start is with the person's felt needs." Because the spiritual, material, physical, financial emotional, intellectual and social needs of people in the community are so diverse, several different types of outreach programs are necessary.

Church outreach is also a means to introduce people in the community to the church by making them aware of God's love for them. Outreach stimulates church growth by mobilizing members to minister to the un-churched. However, growth should not be measured by the number of people in attendance on Sunday morning, but by the number of disciples being produced.

Outreach is only a starting point for many people on their path to a relationship with Jesus Christ. Churches must *pick up* where outreach ends, by providing the worship, fellowship and discipleship opportunities, along with ministry and evangelism to help people in their relationship to Christ. Besides leading people to Christ and drawing people into the church, bringing healing and help and helping our community, outreach encourages the church volunteer as well. This is an important part of the process for growing disciples and fostering fellowship among believers. A church goal of reaching out to the community in love and service, with the ultimate purpose of witnessing to the saving grace of Jesus Christ, brings about unity in the congregation.

Thank you all of our faithful ministry servants who give of their lives tirelessly to share the love of Christ.
