Dear Church Family,

Each New Year many people are making resolutions and plans to make changes in their lives. One of the most common resolutions is the desire to lose weight. Other changes have to do with getting a handle on finances by making a plan to get out of debt or developing a closer walk with God by daily prayer and Bible Study. Some people even make resolutions to be more faithful in their church attendance and giving.

I have found in my life that the times in which I have had someone hold me accountable, I have been more successful in making changes. It is so easy to fall back into old routines and attitudes without someone asking or prompting you to stay the course. This is probably why people who go to Weight Watchers meetings each week and get weighed by the counselor lose more weight than those who try to do it without accountability.

Therefore, His revelation from the Father to us will always be rooted and grounded in the Word and bring HONOR and GLORY to Jesus in our lives (John 16:13-15).

Just like Jesus' disciples could not do without the help of the Holy Spirit, we will not succeed in pleasing God unless we allow Him to help us on a daily basis; engaging Him as our Counselor, Advocate, Intercessor and Strengthener.
