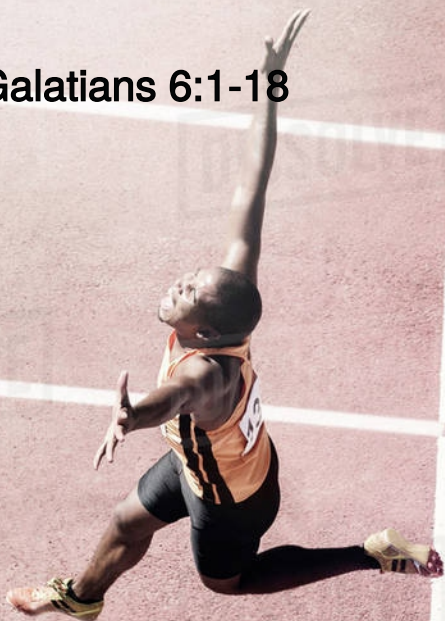


Victory in the New Year: Being Responsible

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church family,

Even though I didn't watch the Super Bowl last Sunday night, I watched the news clips on CBS the next morning talking about how great the Half Time show was. There was nothing but compliments given about the many elaborate costume changes done by Jennifer Lopez while doing her sexually suggestive dance routines. At the same time, I read a lot of posts on Facebook about how the Super Bowl half-time show was not fit for a family to watch together, and that this sends a wrong message to our children about behavior and actions that are acceptable.

If you are a Christian and have an opinion about things that are not healthy for children or adults to watch, you may hear in response, "Times have changed!" This is a common refrain from those who find themselves in contradiction with the Word of God. This happens especially when moral standards are involved.

First of all, one might question what folks mean when they say "Times have changed." Are they talking about a changing culture? Are they talking about changing attitudes—one's view of the world? It is most likely the latter. The idea that times have changed seems to indicate to many people that somehow God's standards have changed with regards to the sanctity of marriage, sexual improprieties, and myriads of other sins.

There is a fundamental truth that is lost in this thinking which leads many to lives of sin: **"Whosoever commiteth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law"** (I John 3:4).

Clearly, sin is sin, regardless how much human attitudes may change. Not only so, neither God nor His Word changes: **"For I am the Lord, I change not..."** (Malachi 3:6); *God is not a man, so he does not lie. He is not human, so He does not change His mind. Has He ever spoken and failed to act? Has He ever promised and not carried it through? (Numbers 23:19);* **"Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away"** (Matthew 24:34).

It is certain that there will be the judgment day coming. Sadly for many, what people think will not be the standard. Jesus said, **"But all who reject Me and My message will be judged on the day of judgment by the truth I have spoken."** (John 12:48).

As we are living in the last days, let me encourage you to stay strong in you walk with the Lord, and remain steadfast in your convictions to live your life according to the instruction of God's word.
