Dear Church family,

I am continuing my review of our Church Membership Covenant. The third part of the covenant commitment is focused on serving the ministry of the church. God has called each member to help strengthen the church through serving Christ through specific ministries.

3. I will serve the Ministry of My Church: ...By discovering my gifts and talents

"Serve one another with the particular gifts God has given each of you..." 1 Peter 4:10 (Ph)

Every person has a particular SHAPE that is unique to every believer. The church functions effectively and joyfully when every person discovers and uses their gifts to build up the body of Christ. Using the **S.H.A.P.E.** acronym, every believer has a **S**piritual Gift that is bestowed on them at the time of their salvation. The Scriptures that speak of spiritual gifts are: Romans 12:6-8, 1 Corinthians 12:4-11, 28-31, Ephesians 4:7-13 and 1 Peter 4:10.

Also, every person has a **H**eart for serving in various capacities. Some people have a heart for children, while others have a heart for administration and keeping things in order. Every person is born with natural **A**bilities. You will discover that your natural ability for serving will compliment the gift or gifts that God gives you. Just as you have Natural Abilities, you have a Specific **P**ersonality that compliments your gift. If you have the gift of teaching and your personality is introverted, your gift would be used to mentor a new believer one to one or to facilitate a small group. Your Life **E**xperience also affects the way in which you use your gifts. Someone with a Life Experience of going through the trial of addiction will fit perfectly with the gift of teaching, mercy, and exhortation in order to help someone going through a similar experience.

...By being equipped to serve alongside my pastors

"God gave...some to be pastors and teachers to prepare God's people for works of ministry, so that the body of Christ may be built up..." Eph. 4:11-12

The calling of a pastor is to train and prepare the body of Christ to serve one another. Somehow the Church developed a mindset that it was the job of the pastors to do all the work of the ministry. An effective church is a church where its people are trained, equipped, and sent out to minister. This is why visiting the sick, leading mission projects, etc, are best handled by those in the church body.
