The Bible teaches that the testimony of the church is to be seen in her members. The strength of every church is determined by how the faith of each member is lived out.

- ...By attending faithfully

"Let us not give up the habit of meeting together...but let us encourage one another." Heb. 10:25

Faithful attendance in meeting together for worship, teaching and fellowship is of utmost importance in developing a strong relationship with God. It has become the practice of many Christians today to allow other worldly commitments to take the place of meeting together with other believers. While the Bible doesn't teach that we are to live our lives sheltered from the living in the world, our testimony to the primacy of corporate worship is noticed by those who watch to see if our lives really reflect a love for Christ. What we support with our time and priorities speak loudly to our friends and families, as well as to the Lord Himself.

- "But whatever happens, make sure that your everyday life is worthy of the gospel of Christ." Phil. 1:27 (Ph) Ephesians 4

Our Christian faith is on display everyday of the week for the world to see. Everything that a believer does, how he responds to situations and conflicts should be Christ-like. Our speech, attitude and demeanor should be reflective of a growing relationship with Jesus. We should be constantly trying to put off the old ways of worldly living, and live in such a way that people can see Christ in all that we do.

- "Each one of you, on the first day of each week, should set aside a specific sum of money in proportion to what you have earned and use it for the offering." 1 Cor. 16:2
- "A tenth of all you produce is the Lord's, and it is holy." Lev. 27:30

The Bible teaches that giving should be done is such a way that it demonstrates our commitment and faith in the provision of the Lord. Scripture teaches that we should give cheerfully and proportionally to how we have been blessed. While many believe that giving of 10 percent is an Old Testament concept, the Lord Jesus teaches that our giving is a demonstration of our faith. The church operates it ministries on the faithful giving of the body of believers. The mission of the church cannot be carried out effectively unless her family supports the church faithfully and consistently. You will not see a growing Christian withhold giving to the work of the Kingdom of God and the local church.

Let me encourage you to re-examine your commitment to your church family, and take the time to reflect on how well you have kept the Membership Covenant when you chose to be part of the EG First family.
