As we approach Christmas, let us all be reminded that this season doesn't need to be dictated by the world in which we live. We have the awesome and God given directive to proclaim Jesus, and what better time than right now! Chances are, we will get caught up in the hustle and bustle of the season. We will get caught up in commercialism, gift buying, decorating, parties, and more. Somehow many of us will forget the true meaning and reason for the season. We see bumper stickers that say "Keep Christ in Christmas", but are we even doing that ourselves? Perhaps those are just empty words that are not lived out in our daily lives. Perhaps we speak one thing, but fail to see them in our actions towards others. Jesus was sent into the world to seek, serve, and save the lost. He came as a child in a manger, and yet for many, that's where the Christmas story ends. It ends up being a sweet story of cute little baby Jesus.
