

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church Family,

Former Boston Red Sox third baseman, Wade Boggs, used to hate going to Yankee Stadium. It wasn't because he had any problems with the Yankees, rather, he hated going because of a fan. That's right: one fan. The guy had a box seat close to the field and when the Red Sox were in town he would torment Boggs by shouting obscenities and insults. It's hard to imagine one fan getting under a player's skin, but apparently this guy had the recipe.

One day before the game, as Boggs was warming up, the "fan" began his typical routine, yelling "Boggs, you stink" and variations of that theme. Boggs decided he'd had enough. He walked directly over to the man, who was sitting in the stands with his friends, and said, "Hey fella, are you the guy who's always yelling at me?" The man said, "Yeah, it's me. What are you going to do about it?"

Wade took a new baseball out of his pocket, autographed it, tossed it to the man, and went back to the field to continue his pregame routine. The man never yelled at Boggs again; in fact, he became one of Wades' biggest fans at Yankee Stadium.

You may find yourself in Wade's shoes someday. For no discernible reason, someone may decide not to like you. Maybe it's something you did, maybe it's something you didn't do, maybe it's something you can't help--but suddenly you find yourself in hostile territory. Our natural inclination is to fight back, but there is a better way to deal with your enemies.

Abraham Lincoln made this observation: "I destroy my enemy when I make him my friend." Also on this subject, the apostle Paul said..."Do not pay anyone evil for evil...If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone." (Romans 12:17-18)

Tossing an autographed baseball to the tormenters you have to deal with may or may not repair the rift, but it will accomplish two things: One, it will knock holes in the case they have built against you. Two, you will have done your part toward to establishing terms of peace.

As Christians, we have a responsibility to do our best to reconcile with our enemies. Remember what Jesus said, ..."You have heard that it was said, 'Love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be sons of your Father in heaven." Matthew 5:44.
