FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church family,

This coming Saturday we are having a *Missions Breakfast* to kick of the week of prayer for our Lottie Moon Christmas Offering. There is no charge for this breakfast and the whole family is invited. I am excited that we will have Missionary David Groseclose, Missionary to Israel, to share a short presentation and answer your questions about what missionaries do to share the Gospel. The breakfast and presentation will be from 9-10:30 am.

The Lottie Moon Christmas Offering theme this year is "Every Church, Every Nation." The International Mission Board (IMB) of the Southern Baptist Convention (SBC) reports that over 2.8 billion people have little or no access to the Gospel. Your prayers and gifts to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering are a tremendous support and blessing in getting His Message out to the nations. Our Lottie Moon national goal is \$160 million. Our church goal is a challenging \$25,000.

Through the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering, you and our church:

- Support over 3,692 missionaries (July 2018)
- Enable disciples to be made and churches to be multiplied around the world
- Help reach out to the 3,200 Unreached people groups that are not currently engaged

An IMB report from 2016 indicates that 45,256 people were baptized overseas; with 30,815 overseas churches; and 4,550 new church starts. *Every penny* given to this offering is used to support Southern Baptist missionaries as they share the hope and grace we have in Jesus Christ. Southern Baptists have been a world leader in sending and supporting missionaries who are sharing the Gospel. The need for more workers and the funds to sustain them on the field is an enormous task, and we must be involved more now than ever.

Thank you, also, for praying for our missionaries, as you make your sacrificial gifts to this yearly offering dedicated to Lottie Moon, who served faithfully the people in China in the 1800's and wrote letters asking for churches to get involved in supporting foreign missions.


