## FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church family,

2 Cor 1:15-19 (NIV) Because I was confident of this, I planned to visit you first so that you might benefit twice. I planned to visit you on my way to Macedonia and to come back to you from Macedonia, and then to have you send me on my way to Judea. When I planned this, did I do it lightly? Or do I make my plans in a worldly manner so that in the same breath I say, "Yes, yes" and "No, no"? But as surely as God is faithful, our message to you is not "Yes" and "No." For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by me and Silas and Timothy, was not "Yes" and "No," but in him it has always been "Yes."

One of the defense mechanisms that a parents learn is not to commit themselves to promises that they cannot keep. Children always remember when you make a promise or a plan that concerns them. They have difficulty in understanding all of the things that adults face in the complexity of life that sometimes causes plans to be altered. When my boys were growing up oldest son asked me to commit to going to a ball-game with him. Because I did not have my calendar in front of me, I gave the safe answer. "Maybe, We'll see." My son apparently was tired of my non-committal answers and blurted out, "Just say, yes or no! Not maybe." He taught me how frustrating it is to hear the answer,"Maybe".

Often, when God asks for our commitment to Him, we return the same answer. We try to play it safe with God so that we will not be guilty of breaking any promises. Then we can say with smug assurance, "see, I told you that I wasn't sure." Many times we are quilty of allowing many other worldly commitments and desires to crowd out our relationship and obedience to the Lord. In the scripture above Paul was saying that he did not give a yes and no answer to the Corinthians concerning his trip to visit them. He was stating that the answer is always "YES!" when it comes to following the Lord's direction. Even more important, the promises that God makes are always kept because of the assurance that was given through the gift of His only Son, Jesus Christ. We can stand firm in Christ and follow His will because He has promised that He has made a deposit on the gift of salvation, which is the Holy Spirit Himself. There is no answer of "maybe" when it comes to knowing Christ as Lord and Savior. The down payment has been made, and the gift has been given. His commitment to us is always Yes, Yes. We belong to God. What is your response to Him?
