IDENTITY: The Unbreakable Connection

Ephesians 5:15-21

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church family,

The message today comes from Ephesians chapter 5, in which Paul exhorts the church to **not get drunk with wine...but be** *filled with the Spirit (v.18)*.

Being filled with the Spirit is contrasted with being filled or drunk with wine. The idea is one of being controlled by God's Spirit rather than by other forces. When we are filled by the Spirit, the results are joy and thanksgiving as well as a posture of humility toward God and of submission to one another.

So how can a person be filled with the Holy Spirit? To be clear, there is an important difference between the indwelling of the Holy Spirit and the filling of the Holy Spirit. All believers in Jesus Christ have God's Spirit living within them, or dwelling within them (John 14:16, Ephesians 1:13, 2 Corinthians 1:22, Ephesians 4:30); but not all believers lives are filled or controlled by the Spirit's power. It has been said believers have all of the Holy Spirit but the Holy Spirit may not have all of them. We are indwelt by the Holy Spirit at the time of our salvation but we are filled by Him when we submit to Him.

The filling of the Holy Spirit can vary in the life of each believer. Negatively, a believer in Christ can *"quench"* or *"grieve"* the Holy Spirit (1 Thessalonians 5:19; Ephesians 4:30). Sinful actions can hinder the work of God's Spirit in a believer's life. In contrast, when a believer in Christ lives in obedience to God's will and commands, he or she should expect to see God's Spirit living through them.

Some suggest that the filling of the Holy Spirit is an emotional experience that takes place at certain moments, but the concept of *"filling"* in Scripture is one of being controlled or influenced by the Holy Spirit. At times, living a Spirit-filled life may include emotional or mountain-top experiences. But the idea of being filled by the Spirit is more about an ongoing sense of God's Spirit working in a person's life, not a one-time experience. As the believer lives out his or her faith in Christ, the Holy Spirit increasingly controls or fills his or her life, which leads to joy, thankfulness, and right relationships. The believer who is Spirit filled will produce the fruit of the Spirit; which in addition to joy includes love, peace, gentleness, kindness, faithfulness, long-suffering, and self control. (Gal.5:22-23) The presence of fruit in a person's life is a great indicator of the Spirit's filling. Are you filled with the Spirit?
