FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church family,

I think it is easy for us to forget our connection to the overall work of the Southern Baptist Churches that are funded through the Cooperative Program. Even though each SBC church is independent, we are connected through our giving and serving together. Because of this voluntary connection, we are able to do great things in promoting the cause of Christ throughout the world. Most people don't realize that the SBC has 41 State conventions, 1,126 local associations, 47,456 cooperating churches with memberships of almost 15 million. Each week there are 5,297,788 people in worship, and last year alone we had a total of 246,442 baptisms.

Southern Baptists have always have had missions as our greatest source of cooperation. We have a total of 3,681 full time international missionaries, and 5,097 missionaries in the United States and Canada. We planted 624 churches and received another 254 existing churches into our fold.

We have a total of 22,808 students currently attending our 6 Seminaries with Southern Seminary in Kentucky having the largest enrollment of 5,497.

The total giving to all causes in our churches added up to \$9,601,534,950.00 with \$463,076,368.00 given to the Cooperative Program last year. The average percentage of gifts given by SBC churches is 4.82 percent. (EGFirst's percentage is 7.5% of our budget) Last year the Lottie Moon Christmas offering for International missions received \$157,306,798.24 and the Annie Armstrong Easter offering for North American Missions received \$61,600,103.86. We gave a reported amount of \$2,647,087.00 to Global Hunger Relief.

We served 2,289,315 meals last year with our disaster relief volunteers who racked up a total of 817,641 hours worked over 103,356 days of volunteering.

So church, when you give your money through the church budget and special mission offerings; please understand that we are connected to a greater ministry together as Southern Baptists. I am proud to be a Southern Baptist, and I pray that you are too.
