

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church family,

One of the things that I miss at this time of year is the long days of sunshine. Living in the Sunshine State for the majority of my life, I am not a fan of the shortened days of daylight. What I am glad about is that Christmas pierces the darkest season of the year with its light. During this time of year a lot of people are facing dark days of disappointment, distress and depression. Even though Christmas is a time of joy, it also can be a time of terrible sadness. In the midst of despair, Christmas brings good news for anyone struggling with dark days during this season. The truth is, God doesn't just want to pat you on the back and say, "Cheer up". God wants to use your dark days to help you learn new attitudes, new choices, new thoughts, and new approaches. God doesn't want to just help survive the holidays He wants to change you. God doesn't just want to chase away the darkness this Christmas. He wants to turn on the lights!

The Bible says, "It is even possible . . . for light to turn the thing it shines upon into light also" (Ephesians 5:13 PHILLIPS). When the light of God shines on my life, it changes everything. It takes me out of that pit of despair and fills me with God's light. Through his light in me, God shines his light on others.

The good news about Christmas is that now there is a light in the world that can drive away the darkness, a light that can drive away your darkness. Jesus-whom the Bible calls the "light of the world"- will walk with you no matter what you're going through. Hold on to God's promises in the book of Isaiah: "I will be with you when you pass through the waters, and when you pass through the rivers, they will not overwhelm you. You will not be scorched when you walk through the fire, and the flame will not burn you" (Isaiah 43:2 CSB).

In fact, that's why Jesus was born. God saw our sin, our pain and our failures so he came to earth as a helpless baby, as *Immanuel, "God is with us."* Think about the first Christmas. I'm sure many people saw the same star that the wise men saw. It may have been millions and millions of people who saw an unusual light in the sky, but most people didn't do anything about it. But the wise men followed the light. I don't want to minimize whatever you're going through this Christmas. But as we celebrate Christmas this year, I pray you'll do what the wise men did. I pray you'll follow the light because that's where Jesus will be this Christmas.
