(Acts 8:13-23 NIV) Simon himself believed and was baptized. And he followed Philip everywhere, astonished by the great signs and miracles he saw. {18} When Simon saw that the Spirit was given at the laying on of the apostles' hands, he offered them money {19} and said, "Give me also this ability so that everyone on whom I lay my hands may receive the Holy Spirit." {20} Peter answered: "May your money perish with you, because you thought you could buy the gift of God with money! {21} You have no part or share in this ministry, because your heart is not right before God.

Just believe and you will be saved. This is the message that is proclaimed from many of our pulpits across the land. Simon believed and was baptized, and then followed Philip everywhere that he went because of the great miracles that were happening. Yet, a few days later, you find Simon being rebuked for wanting to buy the power of God. Was Simon saved? Probably not. Peter tells him that he is full of bitterness and remains a captive to sin.

True conversion demands a changed life. There are many people who have gone through the motions of accepting Jesus and being baptized, yet have not really given their lives to God. There are many people who have gone through the motions of believing without truly giving their lives to Christ. The word "believe" means to commit one's life to Jesus Christ. This is much more than walking an isle and being dipped in a baptismal pool. Believing encompasses every area of our lives and thoughts. When we are truly saved we are released from the bondage to sin. If we are truly saved, the power of God will be evident in our lives. You will not need to buy it, or in Simon's case, put on a performance. The power of God will come as a natural expression of a life that is truly given to Christ.

Somehow, a relationship with Christ has been substituted by a membership in a church. Church membership is good, but will not take the place of a personal walk with Jesus. Just like Simon, we cannot take part in a powerful ministry that demonstrates the power of God apart from a relationship that is real. Genuine spiritual power does not have to be drummed up or manufactured. It is evident through the way we follow the teachings of the Word of God.

Many years ago I remember receiving a compliment. I was told that wherever I went, the power of God was there. Although I felt extremely unworthy of such an evaluation, I realize it should be a statement that should be told about every believer. Have you truly believed in Christ? Is he Lord of every area in your life? Do others see Jesus in You?
