
A city dweller moved to a farm and bought a cow. Shortly after he did, the cow went dry. When he reported this fact to a neighbor farmer, the farmer expressed surprise. The city dweller said he was surprised too. "I can't understand it either, for if ever a person was considerate of an animal, I was of that cow. If I didn't need any milk, I didn't milk her. If I only needed a quart, I only took a quart." The farmer tried to explain that the only way to keep milk flowing is not to take as little as possible from the cow, but to take as much as possible. Is that not also true of the Christian life? Those who only turn to God in need miss the real joy that flows from a daily in-filling of His Spirit.

Many Christians are not living an abundant life in Christ. There are those who are satisfied with only giving a small part of themselves to the Lord and His work and get angry when someone holds them accountable for their lack of spiritual growth and commitment. We should expect great things to happen in our lives today because of the power and promise of the Holy Spirit who dwells within us. As in the example of the cow that ran dry of milk, we don't do anyone any favors by expecting less of them than they can give. Often, we get what we ask for, nothing more, nothing less when it comes to service to the Lord and doing ministry in the Church. Some Christians have the attitude that they should be praised when they give the leftovers of their lives to God. If there is anyone that does not want nor deserve leftovers, it is the Lord. God has promised to give us a relationship that is filled with abundance and joy. He will not run out of time and patience with us as we seek to live a life that is pleasing to God.

Let me encourage you to accept the many challenges that await you this and every day. May you remember that the Christian life is meant to be lived in a state of overflowing power and strength. Expect great things, and get great things in the Lord!

(Ephesians 3:17-21 NIV) so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, {18} may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, {19} and to know this love that surpasses knowledge--that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. {20} Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, {21} to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever!
