

Have you ever noticed that when you talk with people, they seem to be waiting for better and happier days to happen in their lives? Many people think that if they just work hard enough and long enough that one day they will be able to sit back and enjoy the fruit of their labors. Whether it is getting to retirement with money in the bank, going on a dream vacation, or just getting the kids through school, they often discover that when they arrive at their goal, they find themselves still not happy and fulfilled.

Today we begin a new sermon series, "Living in the Promised Land." The focus of this series is that God wants you to experience His presence and blessings every day of your life.
