William Kelly was an outstanding student of the Bible whose scholarship and spirituality made him a real power for God in Great Britain at the close of the 19th century. Mr. Kelly helped a young relative prepare for Trinity College in Dublin, and because of his tutoring, his expertise came to the attention of the professors there. They urged him to take up work at the college and thus distinguish himself. When Mr. Kelly showed a complete lack of enthusiasm, they were puzzled. One of them asked in exasperation, "But Mr. Kelly, aren't you interested in making a name for yourself in the world?" To which Mr. Kelly skillfully replied, "Which world, gentlemen?"

If we are really honest with ourselves, we would most likely agree that too much time is spent in this world trying to achieve greatness and recognition. It is very difficult to focus our affection upon the kingdom of God. Although we pray and seek to place a high priority on our relationship with the Lord, it is difficult to comprehend the value of placing our focus on the Lord. We are reminded that we are raised with Christ, thus implying that we died with him and our sins were buried at the foot of the cross. We no longer should value the things the world values. The quest for fame, riches, and popularity should not be a priority for the believer. Our life is to be wrapped up in the desire to serve Jesus Christ.

It is important to recognize that the Christian can and will often be blessed by the Lord with worldly achievements because he has spent his time doing his best for Jesus Christ. The big difference is that the blessings are granted by the Lord because the focus of his life has been to glorify Him. Every believer should be hoping to hear the words, "Well, done my good and faithful servant, enter into the Joy of the Lord." Our glory will be to appear with Him.
