(Romans 7:14-25 NIV) We know that the law is spiritual; but I am unspiritual, sold as a slave to sin. {15} I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do. {24} What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death? {25} Thanks be to God--through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself in my mind am a slave to God's law, but in the sinful nature a slave to the law of sin.

It is so difficult to break free from the bondage of sin. The Bible states that we are given freedom from the hold of sin in our lives, yet we find ourselves often reverting to the same old habits, desires, and thought patterns that we had before we accepted Christ as our Savior. Paul spoke in this passage of the war that was going on in his own life. As he grew in his relationship with Jesus, he became more sensitive to the desires of the flesh that tried to get him off track in his relationship with Jesus.

The Christian is taught by the word of God and through the leading of the Holy Spirit to understand the things that are wrong and must be put aside. Yet, we are often tempted with many other diversions that come from living in a fleshly sensual world that is controlled by Satan. Many Christians find themselves giving in to the desires of the flesh, because they have not totally surrendered to the mind of Christ.

What can we do about this predicament? We must recognize that only Christ can deliver us from such bondage and failure. We must be willing to admit along with Paul that we have made wrong choices and have done things that we detest.

Our relationship with Jesus will help us learn how to give up the world's hold upon our lives. We must allow the Lord to help us to stay focused on what He desires for us. Even when we give in to the flesh, we must seek forgiveness and deliverance from the Lord. He is the one that can empower us to be overcomers.

May we never become complacent about the sin in our life. Yes, we fail, and so do many others. But we must constantly desire to follow the will of God. He is able to help us win the war that is being waged in our lives. As we grow closer to the Lord, we will discover more and more areas that we need to turn over to the Lord's leadership. May we continue to grow in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
