

A CONSTANT REMINDER

(John 14:26 NIV) But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

Do you ever need to be reminded to do things that need to be done? Most people have a convenient way of forgetting what they don't enjoy doing. We glide right through the events of the day that bring satisfaction to us, and put off doing the things that are unpleasant and difficult.

One of the most difficult things that I do is to spend time with God each and every day. It's not that I don't love God, rather so many other areas in life need so much attention. Like most people, the "to do" list is much longer than the time span to get them done. Often, we can make righteous excuses for avoiding a quiet time with the Lord. We make lots of smoke and noise, but we get nowhere.

Most of us need the Lord to place a burden on our heart and a difficult situation in our lives in order for us to stop using our own power and look to God. The teaching of the Holy Spirit and reminder of our need to follow the instructions given in the word of God comes to us during the times when we feel totally helpless to live life on our own. Many of us have been convicted many different times about the changes that are needed in our hearts and attitudes but are unwilling to follow the Lord's direction. May we remember to heed the direction of God as he makes himself known to us each and every day.
