# FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church family,

Today our hearts are broken for the hundreds of people affected by the events that unfolded in Sutherland Springs last Sunday. While we were worshipping with friends and enjoying our Sunday afternoon lunch with family, unspeakable violence broke out in this small Texas town, taking the lives of 26 worshippers, and injuring almost two dozen more. Two local men courageously pursued the gunman (after the neighbor engaged him in gunfire), and led law enforcement to his location, where he was found dead from a self-inflicted gunshot wound. Among the dead was the 14 year old daughter of the Churches' Pastor. May we continue to keep Pastor Frank Pomeroy and his wife and this Texas town in our prayers as they continue to grieve for the loss of their loved ones.

We live in perilous times, as it seems almost weekly we learn of shootings, car bombings, and violence that is inflicted against innocent people in America and around the world. If there was ever a time we need to share Jesus with the world, it is now. The Bible states that the world will not get better, but as the coming of Christ grows nearer, there will be signs of evil and lawlessness, and the acceptance of sin will be more and more blatant in our society. 2 Timothy 3:1-5 states...."This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come." I doubt that anyone thinks the world is getting better and less sinful, so as a Church we need to become more faithful to Christ and the Great Commission, and develop a prayer lifestyle that includes praying for the lost to come to know Christ and for the Power of the Holy Spirit to be evident in all of our lives.

I am thankful that a couple of years ago our Church made steps toward increasing our Safety and Security each week during the church activities. We have men and women that walk our parking lot and hallways, and we have those who are trained and authorized to protect our congregation should a situation develop. We also have surfaced those in our congregation who are paramedics, doctors, and nurses to help with medical needs. The presence of a policeman who directs our traffic each week adds to our security. Should you wish to volunteer to serve on the Safety and Security Team, please let the office know, and someone from the team will be in contact with you.

May we remember that in this world we will experience tribulation, but praise the Lord, He has overcome the world. (John 16:33) In Christ's Service.
