FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Church family,

2 Corinthians 8:9-12 NLT "You know the generous grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. Though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, so that by his poverty he could make you rich. Here is my advice: It would be good for you to finish what you started...Let the eagerness you showed in the beginning be matched now by your giving. Give in proportion to what you have. Whatever you give is acceptable if you give it eagerly. And give according to what you have, not what you don't have."

During the Christmas season many people get so wrapped up in the spirit of gift giving, that they end up in credit card debt that will take several months or more to pay. We should really take time to think about the true reason for gift giving. We should give gifts to others because of our love for them, and seek to give based on our capacity to give, not just to fulfill their desires. We should give to others with a joyful heart and not out of a sense of obligation. I remember as a 6 year old receiving my first bicycle. I went out to the garage and remember how excited I was to get just what I had hoped for. The bicycle was not brand new, but had been renewed by my Father with a fresh coat of paint and new tires. Even though my parents struggled financially; they made sure that they did their best to provide for me and didn't try and live beyond their means.

Likewise, the Bible teaches us that it is not the size of the gift that matters to God, but rather the willingness of our heart to give according to one's resources. When we give of our resources to the Lord, it should be based on a different motivation. Our reason for giving of our time, talents, and money is not because we owe God. Rather, we should give because of our gratitude for what God has done for us. The word of God states "that though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, so that you through his poverty might become rich."

We should give because of the demonstration of God's love for us. Jesus became poor so that we could become rich in our relationship with the Father. We should never get to the point that we can ever say that we have given enough or that we can't give at all because we can't afford to give. Our gratitude should be so great because of our experience of God blessings; we should try and figure out how much more we can give to the Lord's work. Even when our physical resources are small, the blessings are great when we give a proportional gift to God out of a heart filled with love. Does the giving of your life and resources indicate a true love for God?
