2. I Will Share the Responsibility of my Church

... By praying for its growth

"To the church...we always thank God for you and pray for you constantly." 1 Thess. 1:2

The numerical growth of a church comes by the power of the Holy Spirit working through the body of Christ. A growing church believes that it is God's will that people are reached for the Kingdom of God and that the underlying foundation of a church's growth comes through prayer and fasting. Growth is not achieved alone through worship services, programs and ministries.

... By inviting the unchurched to attend

"Go out into the country...and urge anyone you find to come in, so that My House will be full." Luke 14:23 (LB) Over the last 10 years many churches have adopted the attractional method of growth. If we have the nicest buildings, dynamic preaching, the exciting music, and the best worship atmosphere, the church will grow. This is not the biblical model. It is your responsibility as a member to be inviting people in your family, your neighborhood, your workplace, and in your circle of friendships to attend church with you. There must be a urgency of every member to be part of seeing the church grow and reach people for Christ. We don't want growth simply for the reason of getting bigger. Numerical growth represents people who have come to faith in Christ.

...By warmly welcoming those who visit

"Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God." Romans 15:7 While it is easy to stay connected in our circle of friends at church, every member should be concerned about welcoming and looking to help new people who walk through our doors to feel like they are invited and wanted guests. This is not just the responsibility of the designated greeters. It is the responsibility and joy of every member present. Never point people to a location in the church. Always walk with them.
